We have not changed the fee in years. We also get a small grant from the city each year which helps cover some of our costs.

Members are expected to take care of 2 community plots (of similar size) in which produce for donation to local food banks is grown. We increased our fee a couple years ago and don't expect to increase it further in the near future.

They have stayed fairly steady in price over the years, but I know some gardens did raise them slightly to cover rising costs of some of the garden resources. We encourage them to keep the cost accessible and it can be waived if it would be a barrier to participation for folks living on low incomes

Fee is based on ability to pay and volunteer work. How is this evaluated? City of Burlington offers fee assistance for rec programs, free or discounted facility rentals if open to the public and/or non-profit group, but folks need to apply.

We advise the gardeners at the time we send out the contracts that if they are experiencing financial difficulties, we would handle their situation with discretion and they would not have to pay.

Tax included. The price increases annually subject to Council approval at budget meetings – for example, the 2022 fee was \$95.71 (tax inclusive).

Did not increase the \$46 fee between 2022-23, but did add a \$10 + tax personal liability insurance fee for \$62.80 total plot cost. Recommendation not to increase for 2024 as COB is at the high end for smaller plot sizes. Most plot sizes offered are larger and fees vary, but are mostly lower.
